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## Review of the $o, e$, and $x$ Families of Letters

The italic $o$ is not a circle. It is narrow and should be shaped somewhat like an oval. The italic $e$ may be thought of as an o whose right middle has been cut and sewn to the left side; again, it is narrow and shaped like an oval. The $x$ is made by drawing a diagonal curved line first, and then a straight diagonal line which intersects the first.

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
