- Here is another Greek quotation to memorize: ἀπὸ τοῦ ἡλίου μετάστηθι. It means literally, “Stand out of the sun,” the reply that Diogenes made to Alexander the Great in the legendary story in which the philosopher was asked what he wanted. Alexander could have given him anything in the world, but Diogenes, who was basking in the sun, asked him to move away from the sun.

- Read chapters 74–79 of **Guerber’s Story of the Greeks.**
- Memorize the conjugation of the word λύω (I loose) in the Passive voice. Notice that it is exactly the same as the passive voice. That’s easy!

Singular

1. λύ-ο-μαι, *I am (being) loosed*
2. λύ-η, *you are (being) loosed*
3. λύ-ε-ται, *he is (being) loosed*

Plural

- λυ-ό-μεθα, *we are (being) loosed*
- λύ-ε-σθε, *ye are (being) loosed*
- λύ-ο-νται, *they are (being) loosed*

Present passive infinitive λύ-ε-σθαι, *to be loosed.*

βάλλω, I throw; διδάσκω, I teach

ἐγείρω, I raise up

κηρύσσω, I announce, proclaim

εἰς, into (accusative)

ὑπό, by (genitive); under (accusative)

κρίνω, I judge

στέλλω, I send

σώζω, I save
