Enclitics are words that are pronounced with words that come before it. Does that strike up your interest?
- Here is the quotation that *really* will be food for thought. (I was kidding about the enclitics—you knew that.) The quotation is from Aesop (picture on right): Εὐημερῶν μέμνησο καὶ τοῦ θανάτου. (In the good days remember also death.)
