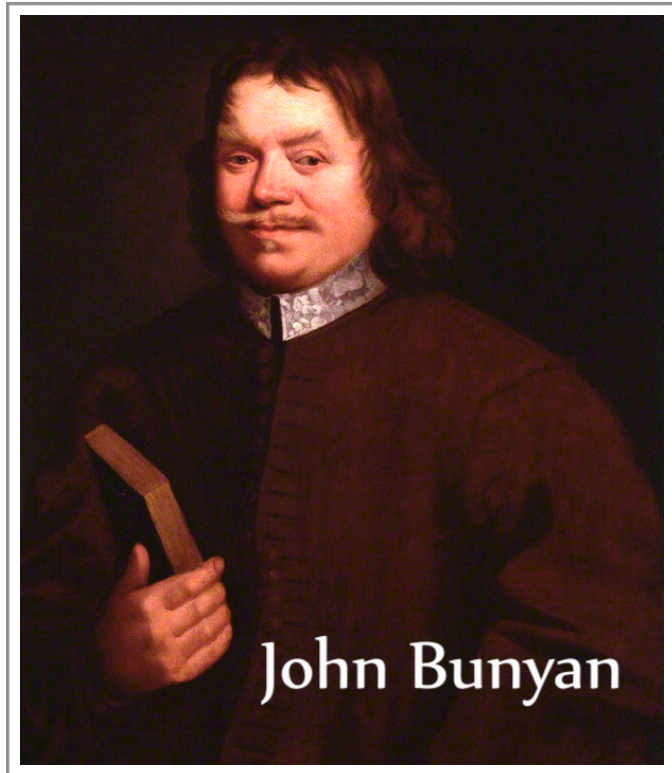


Vice and Virtue Assignment 7

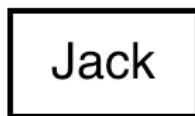
