### Assignment 30

- *poetry memorization.* Memorize stanzas 1-3 of Edgar Allan Poe's "The Bells."
- *phonics, reading and grammar.* Complete Lesson 30 in your *B is for Bear* textbook, volume 2.
- *handwriting.* Complete Lesson 30 of your handwriting book.
- *dictation.* Students should write out Dictation 30, found below.
- Here is another book recommendation: Paul Goble, *The Girl Who Loved Wild Horses*. 1978. Reprint. Athenum, 2001. A myth-like story about a Native American girl who is different from the others—she joins a "tribe" of wild horses.
