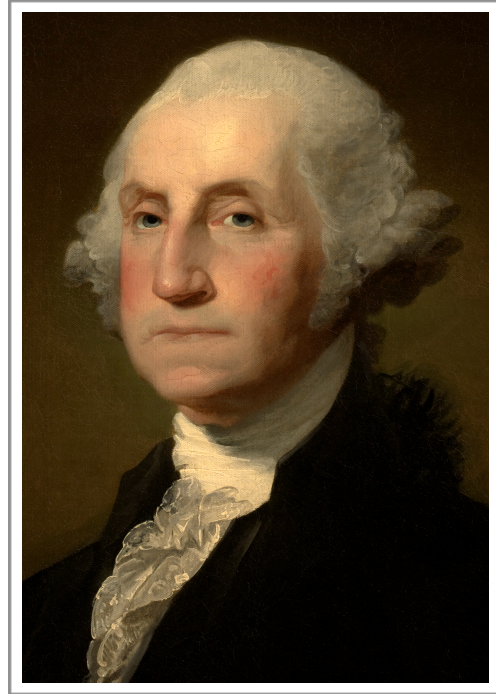


## Vice and Virtue Assignment 14
