# **Color Key**

#### **BLACK**

The green bookmarks worth one point

## **BLUE**

The **blue** bookmarks may trade with teacher for any bookmark, indicated as black or blue

#### **DARK ORANGE**

The dark orange bookmarks worth two points

## **MAROON**

Rules

## **Goal of Game**
