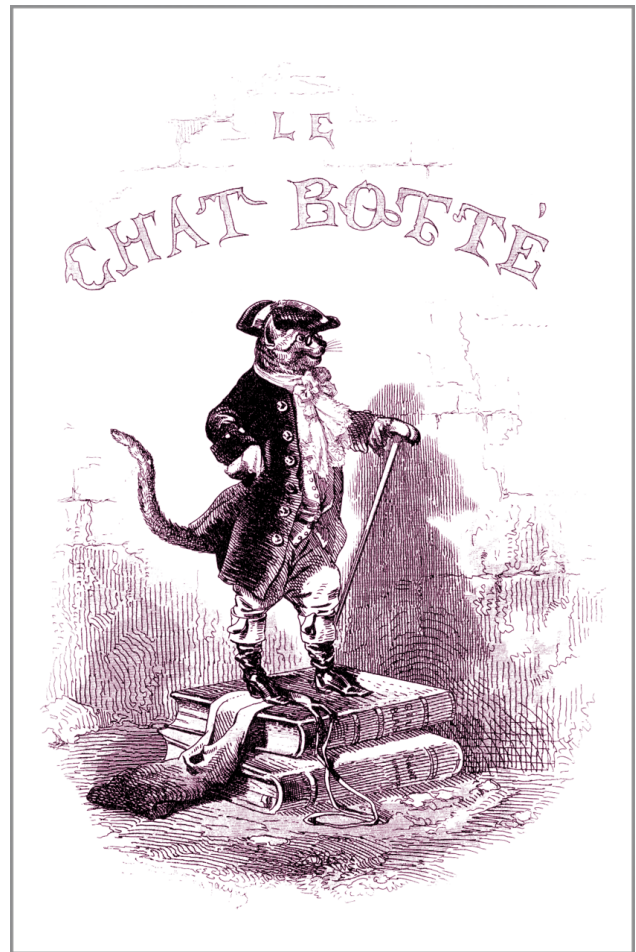


## B is for Bear
