- *poetry bee blog*. Read and study this week's new poetry bee blog. Remember to review the old ones and to review all of the poems in the appendix. There will be additional poems to memorize for the final rounds of the bee.
- *poetry memorization*. Memorize stanzas 1–4 of Christina Rossetti's "Another Spring." There are six stanzas in this poem.
- *literature*. Read Charles Lamb, "Convalescent" and complete all of the study guide material. Also, read George Gordon Byron, Poems in your reader and answer the questions on the poem in your study guide.
- *test*. Finish studying for the test and hand it in this coming Friday. You can find the test online. You will be signing an honor code statement.



Long Range Assignments

- We will have the English literature *and* history exam on the **third Friday of March**. The test will cover all of the literature in the Neoclassical Period and chapters 17–20 in your English history. I will be sure to go over all of the answers for the English history in "Materials Needed." Make sure that you review all of the study guide material for the English literature!
