### Assignment 11

- *Quotation.* Οὐς τρέφεις, ἀγάπα. “Love those whom you rear.” The Greek word τρέφω means to rear or bring up.
- *NGE Vocabulary.* In this section of your assignment sheet are words that we have had before, but would be good to review, as they will not be glossed on the National Greek Exam. Make sure that you know the following vocabulary.
  1. φόβος -ου ὁ panic, fear
  2. χρόνος -ου ὁ time (fem.)
  3. ὁδός -οῦ ἡ road (neut.)
  4. ἀργύριον -ου τό money, silver
  5. ἔργον -ου τό work, deed, exploit
  6. ζῶον -ου τό living being, animal
  7. πρόσωπον -ου τό face, mask, person
  8. σημεῖον -ου τό sign
  9. στάδιον -ου τό (pl. στάδια and στάδιοι) stadion or stade, Greek unit of measure ~ 607 feet
  10. τέκνον -ου τό child
  11. χωρίον -ου τό place, spot, district
  12. εἰκός -ότος τό propriety, probability
  13. ἐλπίς -ίδος ἡ hope
  14. μυριάς -άδος ἡ ten thousand (a countless amount)
  15. νύξ, νυκτός ἡ night
  16. παῖς, παιδός, ὄ/ἡ child; slave
  17. πατρίς -ίδος ἡ fatherland
  18. πούς, ποδός ὁ foot
  19. προσήκοντα -οντων τὰ duties
  20. προσήκοντες -οντων οἱ relatives
- *Review.* Review the IMPERFECT AND SECOND AORIST forms, including indicative (active, middle and passive) and subjunctive (active, middle and passive) on pages 1 and 2 on the **conjugation sheet**.
