- *translation.* Translate Section 292 on page 119 in Davis, from Greek to English.

- *quotation to memorize:* πάντα ἰσχύω ἐν τῷ ἐνδυναμοῦντί με. (Philippians 4:13)
 - * πᾶς (pronoun) accusative, plural, neuter
 - * ἰσχύω (verb) present, active indicative 1st person singular
 - * ἐν (preposition)
 - * ὁ (article) dative, singular masculine
 - * ἐνδυναμῶ (verb) present, active participle, dative, singular, masculine
 - * ἐγώ (personal pronoun) accusative, singular
