- *Grammar and Translation.* Study Gleason and Atherton, chapter 21. This week's lesson is on adverbs and comparisons. The adverb can be immediately recognized by the ως ending. Note that the comparative of the adverb is the neuter accusative *singular* of the corresponding adjective; the superlative is the neuter accusative *plural*. Also, note the irregular comparisons of μάλα, ἄνω, and ἐγγύς:
 - μάλα. μᾶλλον, μάλιστα
 - * ἄνω, ἀνωτέρω, ἀνωτάτω
 - * έγγύς, έγγύτερον, έγγυτέρω (or έγγύτατα, έγγυτάτα)
