

## Classical Greek Assignment 15

- The Greek quotation to memorize this week is from the Mark 1:15, in which John the Baptist says: μετανοείτε καὶ πιστεύετε ἐν τῷ εὐαγγελίῳ, or Repent and believe the gospel. The word μετανοέω means “repent,” and the word πιστεύω means “believe.” The word εὐαγγέλιον (gospel) is made up of a prefix εὐ, which means “good” and ἀγγέλος, which means “news” or “message,” which is sometimes translated “angel.” Incidentally, the word *gospel* is an Anglo-Saxon word made of the *gōd* (good) and *spel* (speech or news).
