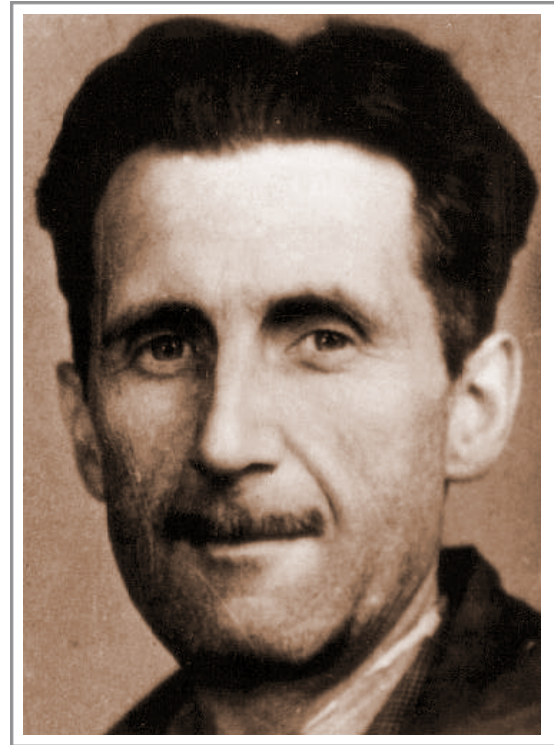


## Classic Works

### Assignment 3

- Memorize stanzas 1–3 of John Keats' poem "To Autumn."
- Read Orwell's *Animal Farm*, chapters 1–3 and complete all of the study guide material. You can acquire the book at any library or books store, but until you do, you may read it online under "Materials Needed."
- The picture on the upper right of this assignment sheet is of George Orwell.
- You will work on the five-paragraph essay comparing the myth "Cupid and Psyche" and Mother Holle. This week you will write your introduction and your first body paragraph, which will include 1) a topic sentence (Example: "One similarity between "Cupid and Psyche" and "Mother Holle" is the ostracism of the protagonist."); 2) relating "Cupid and Psyche" to the topic sentence; in other words, explaining the topic sentence in terms of the myth; 3) relating "Mother Holle" to the topic sentence; in other words, explaining the topic sentence in terms of the fairytale. Be sure to use a transitional expression (printed in bold blue) connecting the two works: **Like the protagonist** in "Cupid and Psyche," the protagonist in "Mother Holle" . . . 4) Talk about the significance of the comparison.
