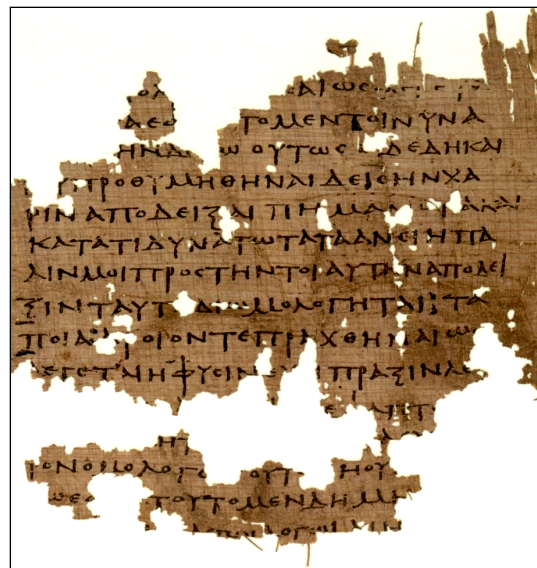

Assignment 9

- *Quotation.* Παιῖς ὦν κόσμιος ἴσθι. Ἡβῶν ἐγκρατής. Μέσος δίκαιος. Πρεσβύτης εὐλογος. “As a child be well-behaved. As a youth—self-disciplined. As of middle-aged—just. As an old man—sensible.” Here is the vocabulary for the quotation:
 - **κόσμιος** well-ordered (remember that κόσμος means world or the order of the world from chaos)
 - **ἴσθι** be (imperative voice)
 - **Ἡβῶν** present participle of the word ἡβάω, be in the prime of youth
 - **ἐγκρατής** self-controlled
 - **εὐλογος** having good reason
- *NGE Vocabulary.* In this section of your assignment sheet are words that we have had before, but would be good to review, as they will not be glossed on the National Greek Exam. Make sure that you know the following vocabulary.

 13. θεός -οῦ, ὁ/ἡ god, goddess
 14. θυμός -οῦ ὁ soul, spirit
 15. ἵππος -ου ὁ horse
 16. καιρός -οῦ ὁ the right time
 17. κίνδυνος -ου ὁ danger
 18. κόσμος -ου ὁ order, decoration, world
 19. κύκλος -ου ὁ circle
 20. κύριος -ου ὁ lord, master
