- Quotation. Παῖς ὢν κόσμιος ἴσθι. Ἡβῶν ἐγκρατής. Μέσος δίκαιος. Πρεσβύτης εὔλογος. "As a child be well-behaved. As a youth—self-disciplined. As of middle-aged—just. As an old man—sensible." Here is the vocabulary for the quotation:
