## Classic Works Assignment 2

- Memorize stanzas 1–2 of John Keats' poem "To Autumn."
- Read Hans Christian Andersen's fairytale "The Swineherd" and answer the multiple choice questions. One of the most famous fairytales is "Cinderella." Watch a production of Cinderella. (Optional) The production is very different from the ordinary rendering of the tale. Always be ready for a quiz on any of the material that read for homework!
- Continue writing your fable, due the last Friday in September. I will correct it and post it online for your classmates to read.
- Read "Cupid and Psyche" and be able to answer questions on the myth in your study guide. Also read all of the study guide instruction.



You do not have to write out the questions. The picture on the right is of Psyche outside the palace of Cupid.

- Read "Pyramus and Thisbe" and answer the multiple choice questions in your study guide. Also read all of the study guide instruction.
- You will be writing a five-paragraph essay comparing the myth "Cupid and Psyche" and Mother Holle. You will prepare for this assignment by first coming up with the main ideas of your essay. Your assignment this week is to write three complete sentences that identify three ways in which the myth and the fairytale are similar. Example sentence: "One way in which the myth of Cupid and Psyche and the fairytale of Mother Holle are similar is the ostracism of the protagonists."

## Long-Range Assignment

Your five-paragraph essay comparing the myth "Cupid and Psyche" and the fairytale "Mother Holle" will be due **on the last Friday in September**. We will be working on it on class next week.
