- *poetry bee blog.* Be sure to memorize the next poetry bee blog! Note that the poems for the final rounds of the bee have been posted. Study the new blog!
- *poetry memorization.* Memorize stanzas 1–3 of William Wordsworth’s “I Wandered Lonely as a Cloud” in class.
- *poetry and poetics.* Complete Poetry and Poetics 25: Rhyme Schemes.
- *grammar and punctuation.* Grammar and Punctuation Lesson 25.
- *literature.* Complete Lesson 25 in your study guide after doing the accompanying reading.
- *picture.* The picture on the upper right is of William Wordsworth, the author of “Alice Fell,” “Andrew Jones,” and of the poem that you are memorizing, “Daffodils.” We will be celebrating Daffodils Day on April 19 (the real day is April 15, 1802, when Wordsworth took a walk and saw the daffodils). Mark it on your calendar!
