English Literature

- *poetry memorization*. Memorize stanzas 1–3 of Girard Manley Hopkins' poem, "Binsey Poplars." There are six parts to this poem.

 "Bannockburn," a biography of Geoffrey Chaucer (pictured on the upper left) and a

- *vocabulary*. Make sure that you study the vocabulary and complete the two vocabulary exercises.
- *literary terms*. This week's literary terms include *rhymed couplets* and *frame story*.
