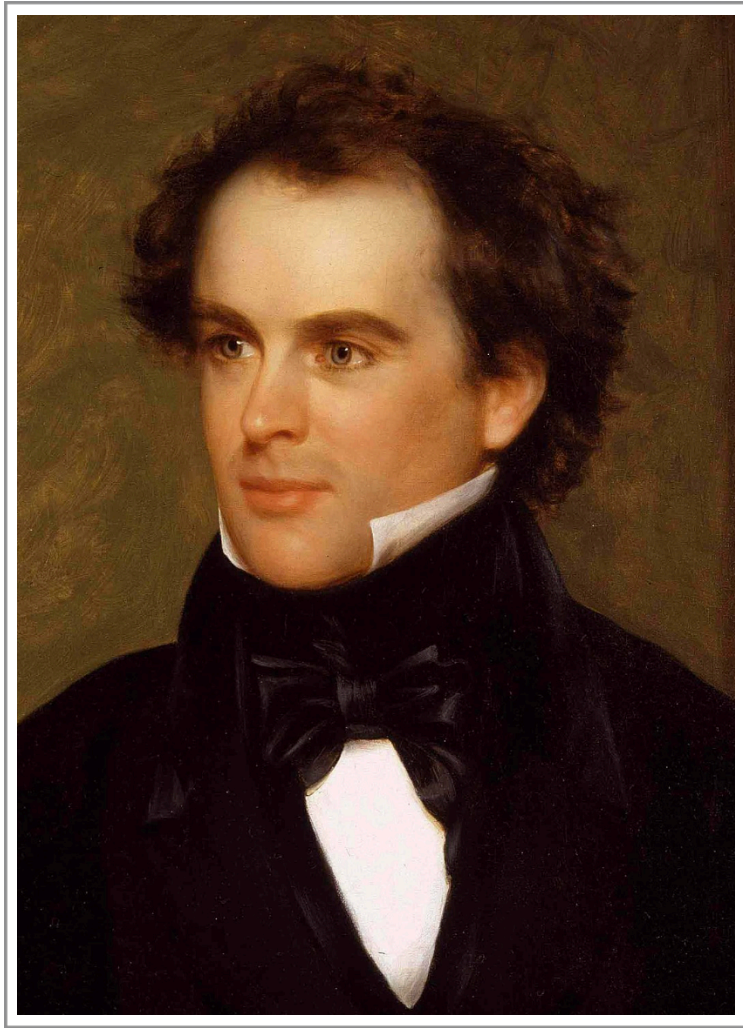


## Foundations in History and Literature

### Assignment 18

- *poetry*. Memorize part 5 of William Blake's "Echoing Green."
- *quotation*. Memorize Quotation #19 by the ancient Chinese philosopher Confucius (551–479 B.C.): *Study the past if you would divine the future.*
- *poetry and poetics*. Complete Poetry and Poetics 19 in your Poetics textbook. This week you will complete your study of repetition with *anadiplosis* (a chain of repetition, such as the statement *Strength will give you bravery, bravery will give you resolution, and resolution will give you victory*) and *antimetabole* (a mirror repetition, such as when JFK said, *Ask not what your country can do for you; ask what you can do for your country*).
- *literature*. Complete Lesson 19 of your study guide and read the corresponding literature. This week you will be reading historical stories by the famous American writer Nathaniel Hawthorne.
- *speech day*. This year you will write poem that you will memorize and deliver on Speech Day. This week I want you to think of your topic and format (ballad stanza, sonnet, couplets, etc.).
