- You will be taking an essay test on *The Mayor of Casterbridge* on the last Friday in February. You can write about any of the topics suggested by the class discussion questions, such as how 1) Hardy uses Farfrae as a foil character to Henchard 2) Henchard is portrayed as a fated tragic hero 3) Hardy contrasts the past with the present using the various customs described and the setting to underscore his tragic themes 4) The Mayor of Casterbridge mirrors many of the characteristics found in Sophocles' Oedipus Rex, including the protagonist as a tragic hero, the plot line, the tragic ending, as well as the very concluding words.
