Classical Greek Assignment 1

- Memorize the alphabet that appears on page 1 of Atherton (found in "Materials Needed"). You will want to be able to say all the letters without a hitch from alpha to omega.
- Memorize the sounds of the letters as well as the vowel combinations (called diphthongs) on page 2 of Atherton.
- Practice writing the letters, using the sheet that I have provided under "Materials Needed." Also, I show you how to make the letters in this video. (See if you can tell which letter I mistakenly skipped!)
- There may be one or more questions on the National Greek Exam that deal with Greek mythology. Sometimes there is one, sometimes four, sometimes *none*. Since there are so few questions (maybe none) on the NGE that will involve Greek mythology, and since we have such limited time in class, it would make more sense for us to focus on just the language. Besides, in the past, most of my students already had studied Greek mythology. If you don't feel confident about your knowledge in Greek mythology, you may want to do some
