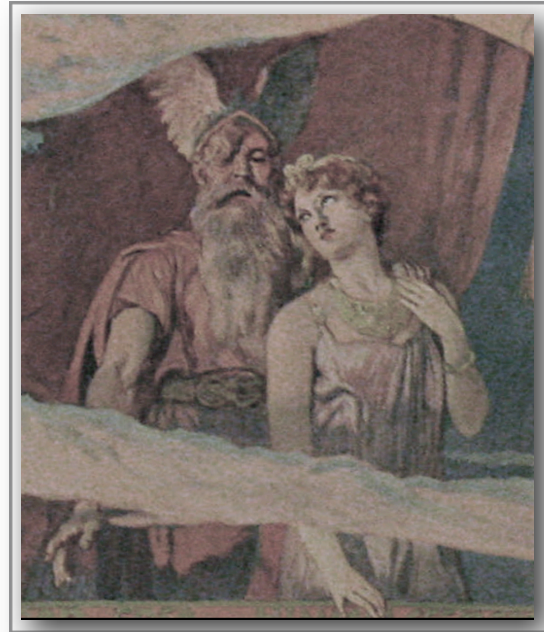


B is for Bear
