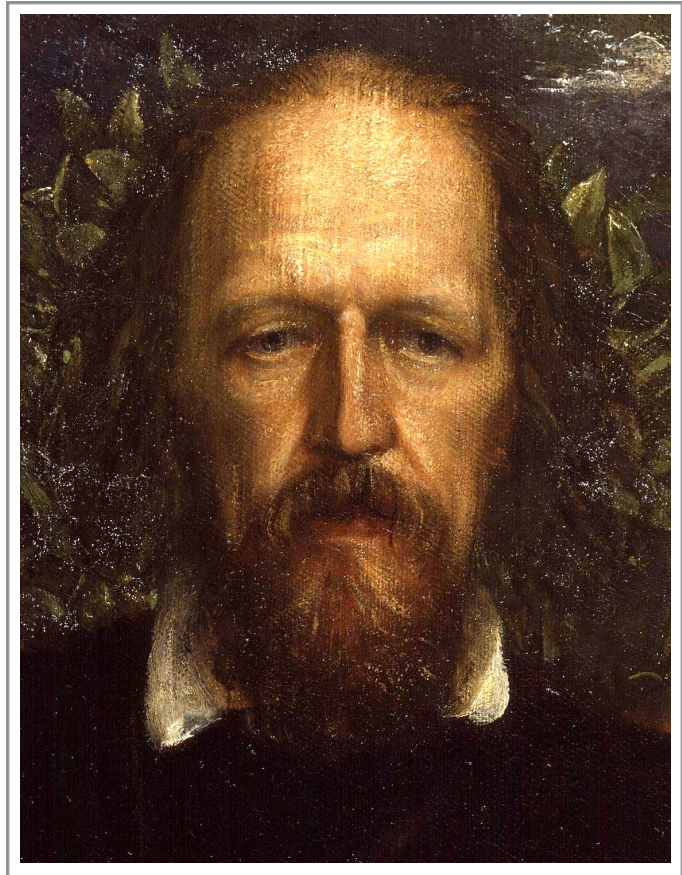


**Great Books Seminar**
