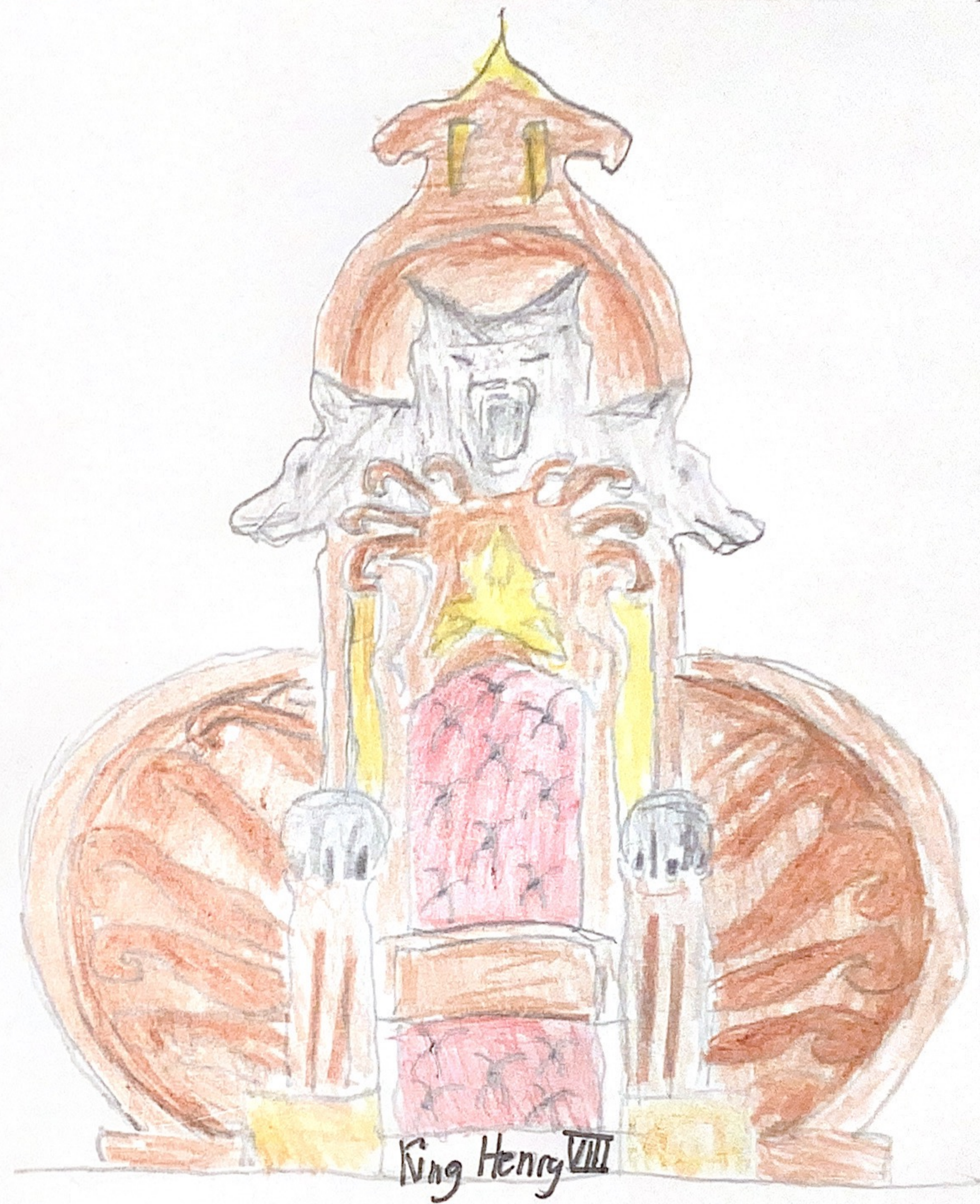


King Henry VIII and his

Henry VIII made many laws and he kept England safe from his enemies. Henry grew very idle so he asked a good friend named Wolsey to help him rule.



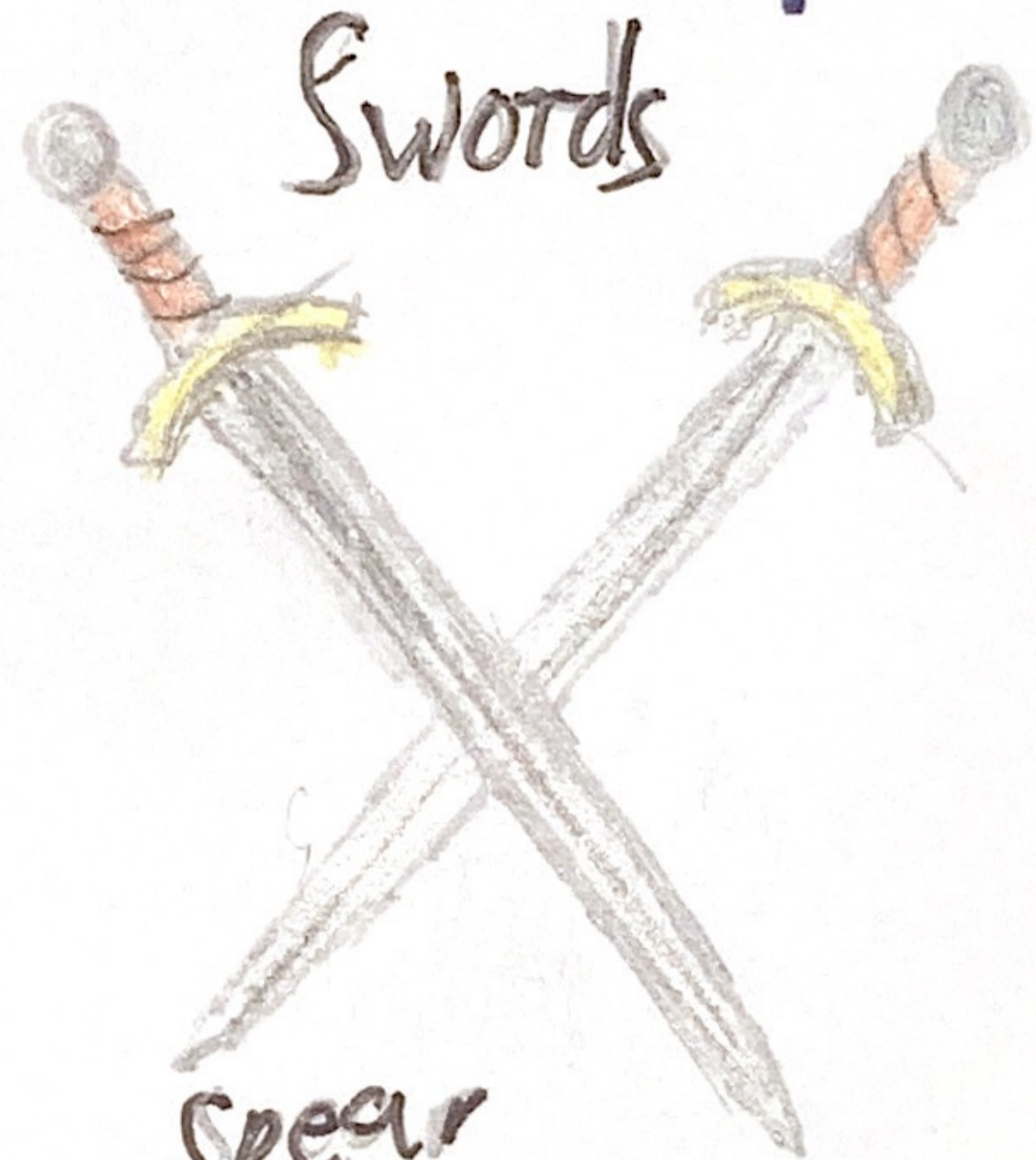


Henry wanted to be a strong king and he decided to do that he must get loads of money. Henry became a very powerful king. Soon other kings wanted to be his friends.

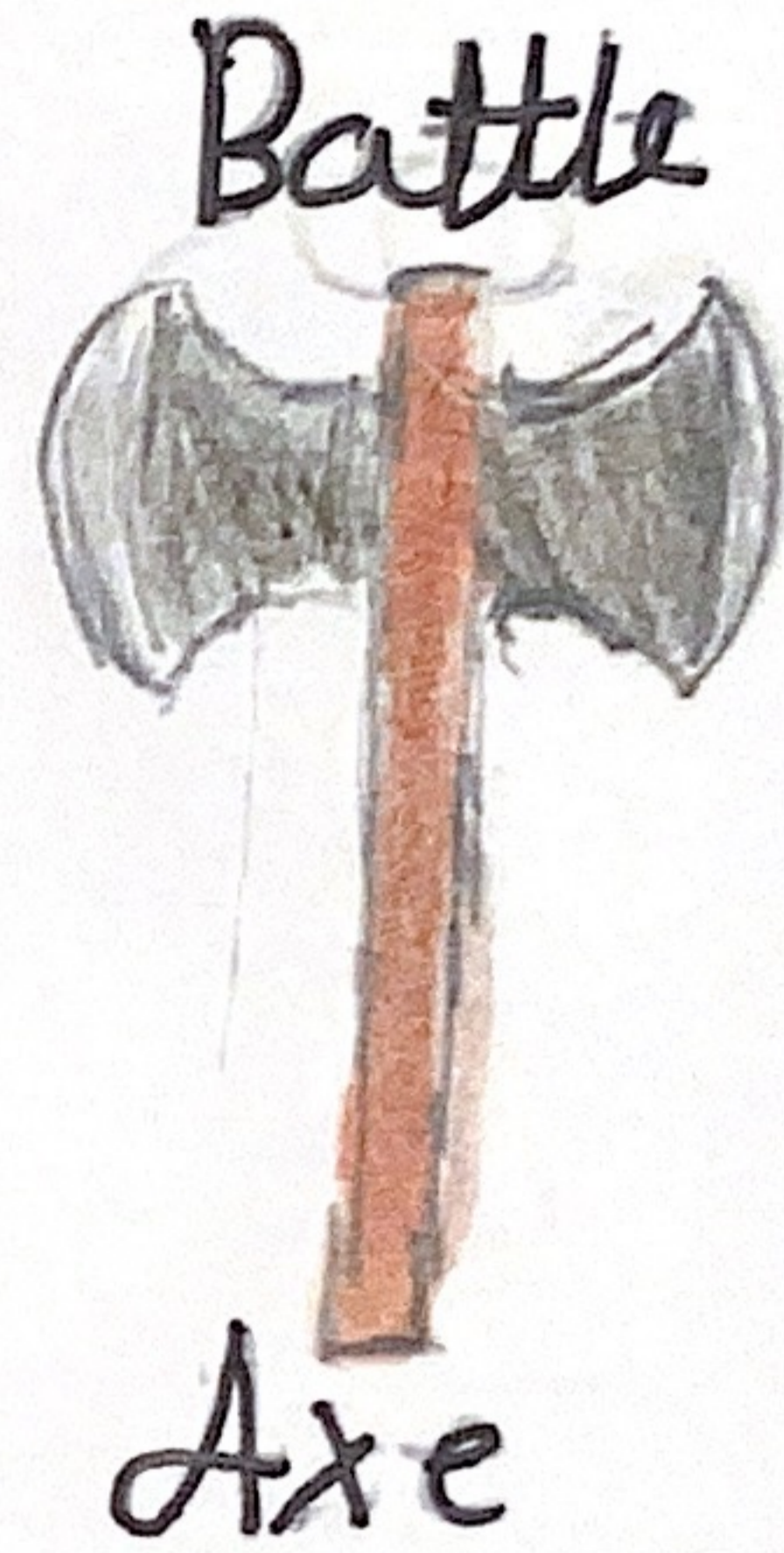
Henry "lost" his old wife so he married a woman named Anne. Henry needed someone to help him rule so he asked a man by the name of Thomas Cromwell to help him.

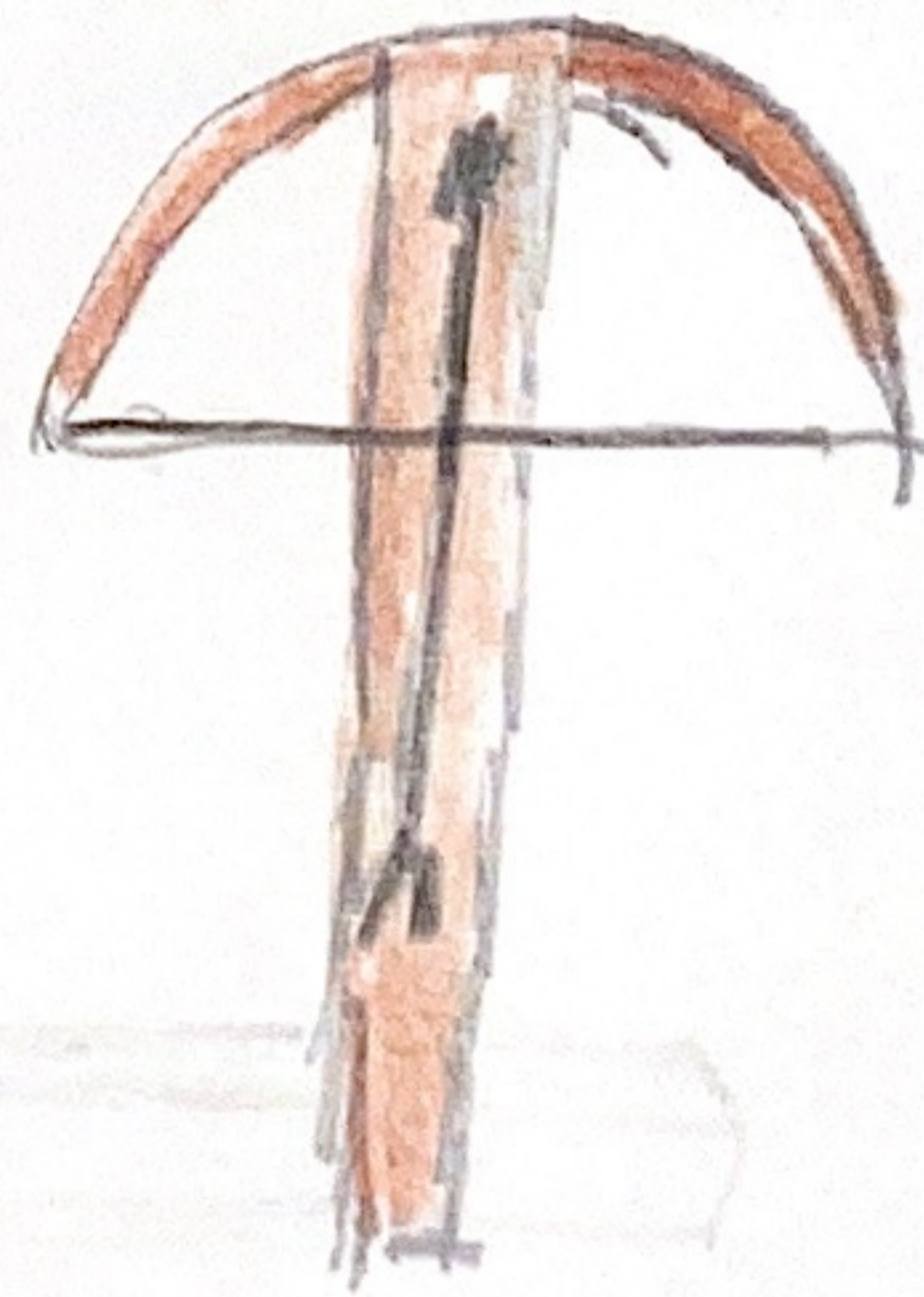

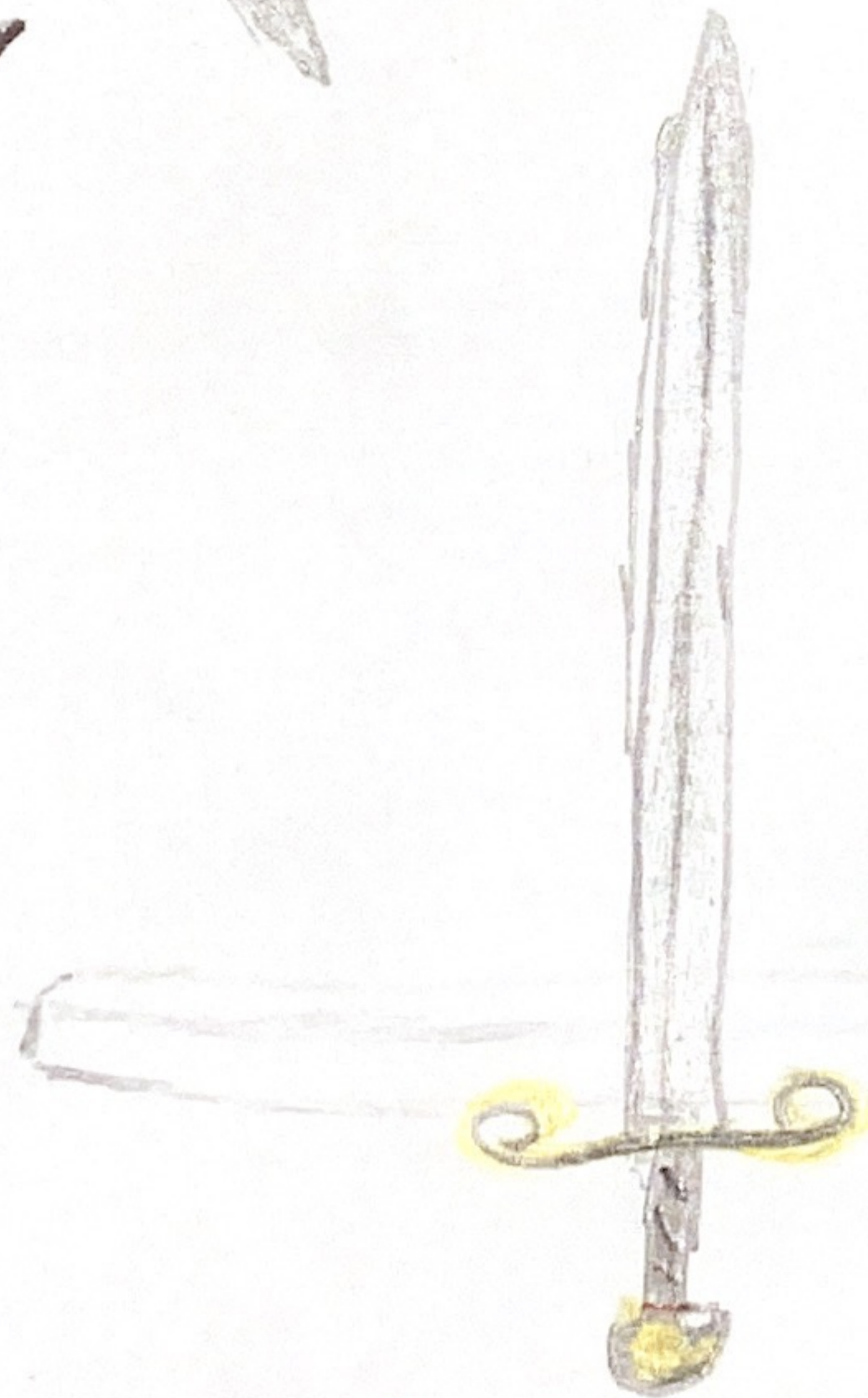


