

Lesson 2: The 'a' Family of Letters

The *a* family of letters include the a, c, d, g, and q. Each of these letters are all made in a counter-clockwise direction, starting on the diagonal line. Just like the letter *j*, the bottom of the letter *g* is flat, or parallel to the bottom line. Like all of the letters, there should be equal space between the letters and inside the letters.
