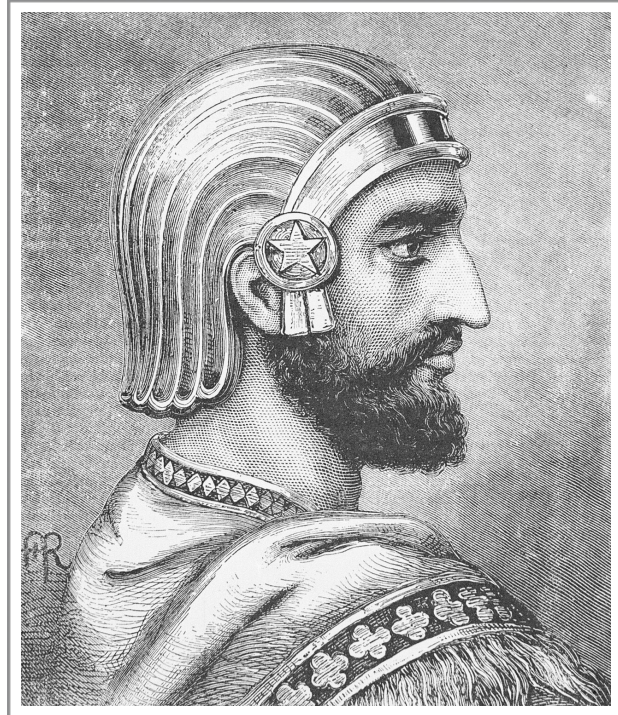


## Greek III

### Assignment 12

- *Quotation.* Γλῶτταν ἴσχε. “Restrain the tongue.”
  - γλῶττα (γλῶσσα) tongue; speech
- *NGE Vocabulary.* In this section of your assignment sheet are words that we have had before, but would be good to review, as they will not be glossed on the National Greek Exam. Make sure that you know the following vocabulary.
  1. συμφέρον -οντος τό use, advantage
  2. ὕδωρ, ὕδατος τό water
  3. ὑπάρχοντα -οντων τὰ circumstances
  4. φῶς, φωτός τό light
  5. χάρις -ιτος ἡ favor, thanks (stem in -ματ-)
  6. αἷμα -ατος τό blood
  7. γράμμα -ατος τό letter
  8. ὄνομα -ατος τό name
  9. πνεῦμα -ατος τό wind, breath, spirit
  10. πράγμα -ατος τό thing; (pl.) circumstances, affairs, business
  11. στόμα -ατος τό mouth
  12. σχῆμα -ατος τό form, appearance
  13. σῶμα -ατος τό body
  14. χρῆμα -ατος τό thing, (pl.) money (stem in -ν-)
  15. ἀγών -ῶνος ὁ contest
  16. δαίμων -ονος, ὁ/ἡ spirit, god, demon
  17. ἡγεμών -όνος ὁ guide, commander (stem in -ρ-)
  18. ἀνὴρ, ἀνδρός ὁ man
  19. θυγάτηρ -τρὸς ἡ daughter
  20. μάρτυς -υρος ὁ/ἡ witness
  21. μήτηρ, μητρὸς ἡ mother
