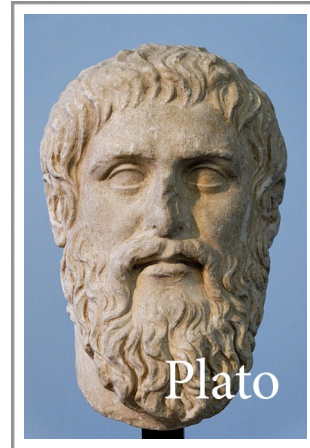


Classical Greek Assignment 10

- Review the quotations below. I will quiz you in class—on the pronunciation, on the memorization and the meaning.
 - ὁ χρόνος ἰατρός τῶν πόνων ἐστίν.
 - χαλεπὰ τὰ καλά.
 - Ἐγὼ εἶμι ὁ ποιμὴν ὁ καλός. (John 10:11)
 - Ἐγὼ εἶμι τὸ φῶς τοῦ κόσμου. (John 8:12)
 - Ἐγὼ εἶμι ὁ ἄρτος τῆς ζωῆς. (John 6:35)
 - Βραχὺς αἰών. (Euripides)
 - κοινὰ τὰ τῶν φίλων. (Euripides)
 - τῷ σοφῷ ξένον οὐδέν.

Translate the following from English to Greek.

II. 1. In the world and in the temple. 2. From the temple and from heaven. 3. The apostles receive bread for the servants. 4. We know the law and believe. 5. The son wishes to speak to the children.

- Memorize the following sixteen Greek words (some are review!):
 1. κίνδυνος danger
 2. κόσμος order, decoration, world
 3. κύκλος circle
 4. λαός the people, folk
 5. λίθος stone
 6. νόσος disease

7. ξένος guest/friend/host; foreigner, stranger
8. οἶκος house, home, family
9. ὄπλον weapon, tool (mostly pl.)
10. πολέμιοι the enemy (do not confuse with πόλεμος, war)
11. ποταμός river
12. στρατηγός general
13. στρατός army
14. σύμμαχοι allies
15. τόπος place, topic
16. τρόπος way, turn

Memorize the conjugation of “to wash” in the middle voice.

<i>Singular</i>	<i>Plural</i>
1. λού-ο-μαι, <i>I wash myself</i>	λου-ό-μεθα, <i>we wash ourselves</i>
2. λού-η, <i>you wash yourself</i>	λού-ε-σθε, <i>ye wash yourselves</i>
3. λού-ε-ται, <i>he washes himself</i>	λού-ο-νται, <i>they wash themselves</i>
