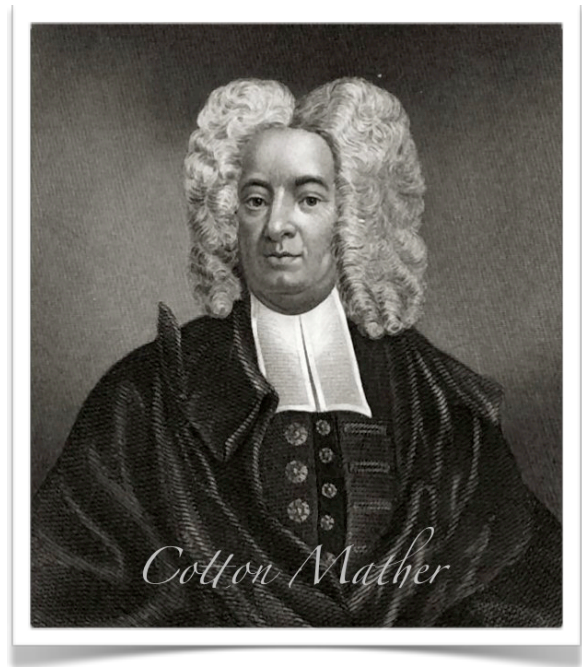

Assignment 13

- Finish memorizing Isaac Watts' poem "Through Every Age Eternal God."
- Complete Grammar and Punctuation 7 in your Grammar and Poetics textbook.
- Memorize Quotation 14.
- Listen to *The Bay Psalm Book*, which was the *first* book published in America by John Eliot. Remember that Hawthorne wrote about Eliot in his history of America, which you read just a few weeks ago. You can find the post on the assignment page under "Materials Needed."
- Study the vocabulary for *True Stories from New England* (Part 2) by Nathaniel Hawthorne in your study guide and read the story in your reader. Complete the study guide material.
- Memorize the vocabulary for Boyhood Biographies: John Paul Jones by R. S. Holland in your study guide. (This means you have *two* sets of vocabulary lists to memorize, but do not be daunted by the prospect; remember it only takes about a few minutes to memorize the words.) Read the story in your book, and complete the study guide material.
