- *reading.* Complete Lesson 28 in your study guide after doing the accompanying reading. You will be reading stories about greed and covetousness, including Guy De Maupassant's "My Uncle Jules," a poem by Thomas Hood, and the well-known story of Midas.
- *poetry and poetics.* Complete Poetry and Poetics 28. You will be learning about epic poems.
- *poetry memorization.* Memorize stanza 1 of Emily Dickinson's "Morning."
- *picture.* The picture on this assignment sheet is of King Midas and his daughter whom he turned to gold.
- *riddle.* Of course, another riddle! What do you expect?
