 - 1. Include a main idea as the last sentence of the first paragraph. Example: Through the character Tom Towers and his periodical *The Jupiter*, Trollope satirizes the arrogance, narrow-mindedness and inaccuracy of the media.
 - 2. Include a topic sentence for each of the body paragraphs, which will appear at the very beginning.
 - 3. Write a conclusion which talks about the significance of your discussion of Trollope's satire. You *may* answer questions, such as *Is the satire still relevant today?* and *Does the satire reflect liberal or conservative views?*
