When Roman numerals are arranged from lower to higher in a line, they are added; thus, XII is 12, VI is 6, and MC is 1100. When two Roman numerals are arranged from higher to lower in a line, the second number is subtracted from the first; thus, IV is 4, IX is 9, and CM is 900.
