

Classical Greek Assignment 19

- The quotation to memorize this week is a logical paradox, attributed to a man from Crete named Epimenides. He said, Κρήτες ἀεὶ ψεῦσται, which means “Cretans always lie.” The Apostle Paul apparently quotes him in Titus 1:12 when he says, “One of the Cretans, a prophet of their own, said, “Cretans are always liars, evil beasts, lazy gluttons.”

- For the last two weeks, we have been going over words in the feminine first declension. You should have noticed that the words all ended in an η; however, they do not always end in an η. Many end in an α. Here are some more 1st declension feminine words that I would like you to memorize:

ἁμαρτία, ἡ, <i>sin</i>	καρδία, ἡ, <i>heart</i>
βασιλεία, ἡ, <i>kingdom</i>	σοφία, ἡ, <i>wisdom</i>
ἐκκλησία, ἡ, <i>assembly, (church)</i>	ἀλήθεια, ἡ, <i>truth</i>
ἐξουσία, ἡ, <i>authority, power</i>	ἀσθένεια, ἡ, <i>weakness</i>
ἡμέρα, ἡ, <i>day</i>	μάχαιρα, ἡ, <i>sword</i>
