Assignment 8

- *poetry memorization.* Students should memorize stanza 5 of the poem “I Remember, I Remember,” found in the appendix.
- *reading and phonics.* Complete all of the material found in **Lesson 8**.
- *dictation.* Before giving the dictation, teachers should review the following: 1) *ir* words 2) *aw* words 3) capital letters for names, at the beginning of sentences, with quotations, with titles of books, with people’s names, the word *I*, and calendar events, such as days of the week, months of the year, and holidays, and proper nouns.

You can tell your child that Benjamin West once lived in the house on Rt. 252 in Newtown Square (now called the Square Tavern, close to West Chester Pike), as well as in Springfield (now in Swarthmore on the campus of Swarthmore College).
