In 1483 a wicked man named Richard of Gloucester became protector, which means he was the ruler of England until the young king Edward V was old enough to rule



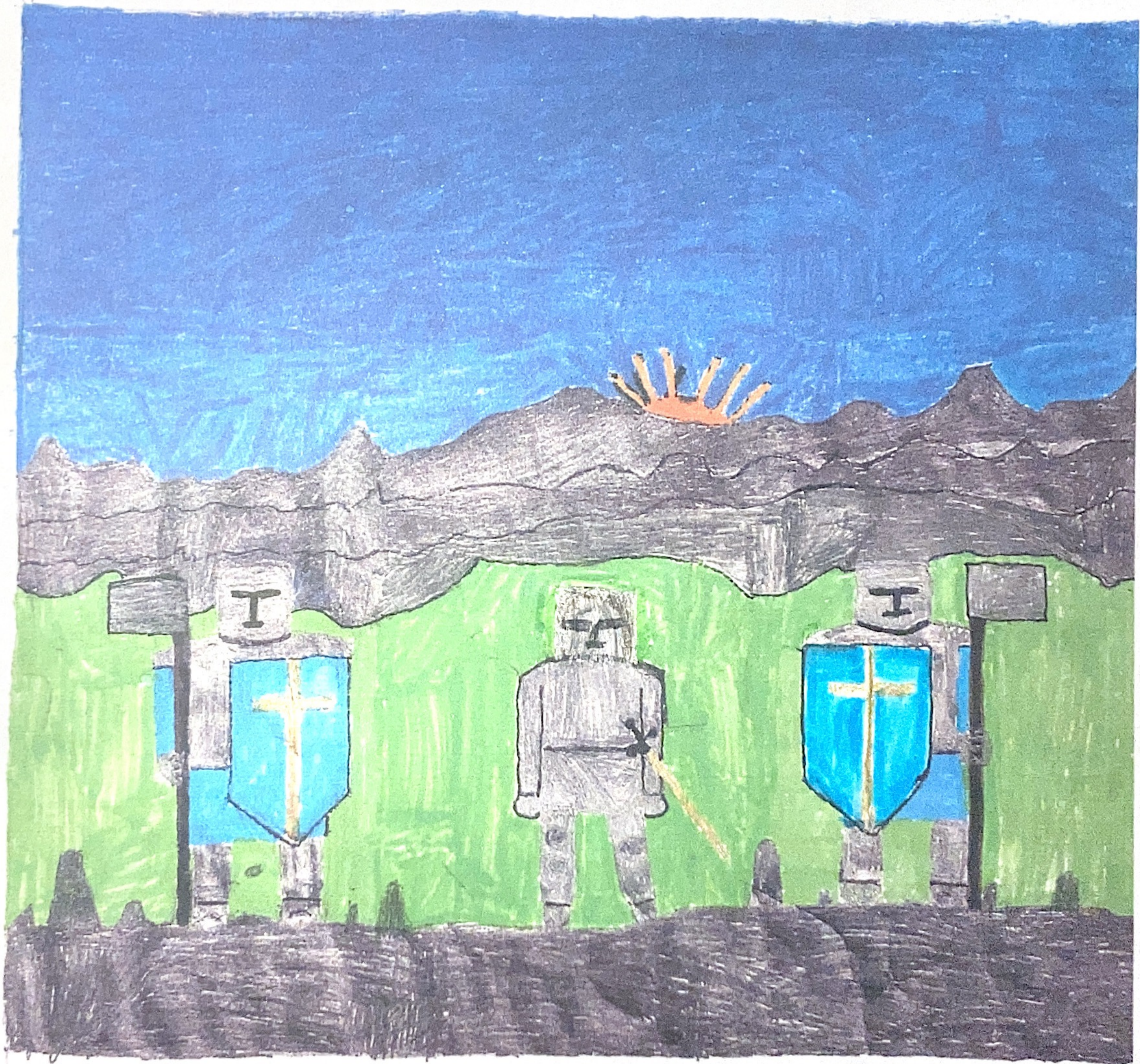
Richard got rid of all the men who might oppose him; he even killed many of the Queen's relatives.



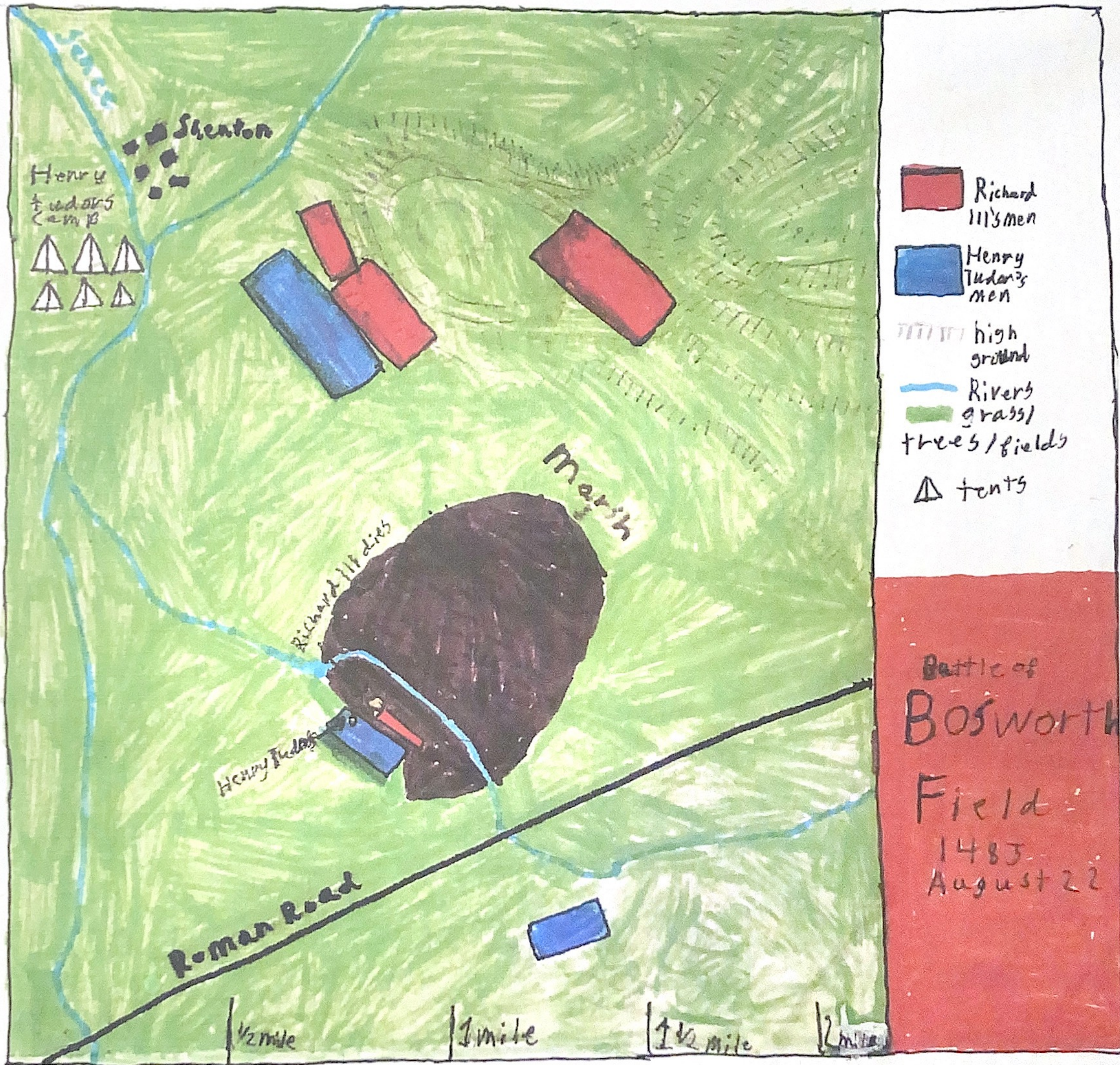
After that, he did more bad things and one of them was that he made himself king!



He then killed Edward V and his brother, who were in the Tower of London.



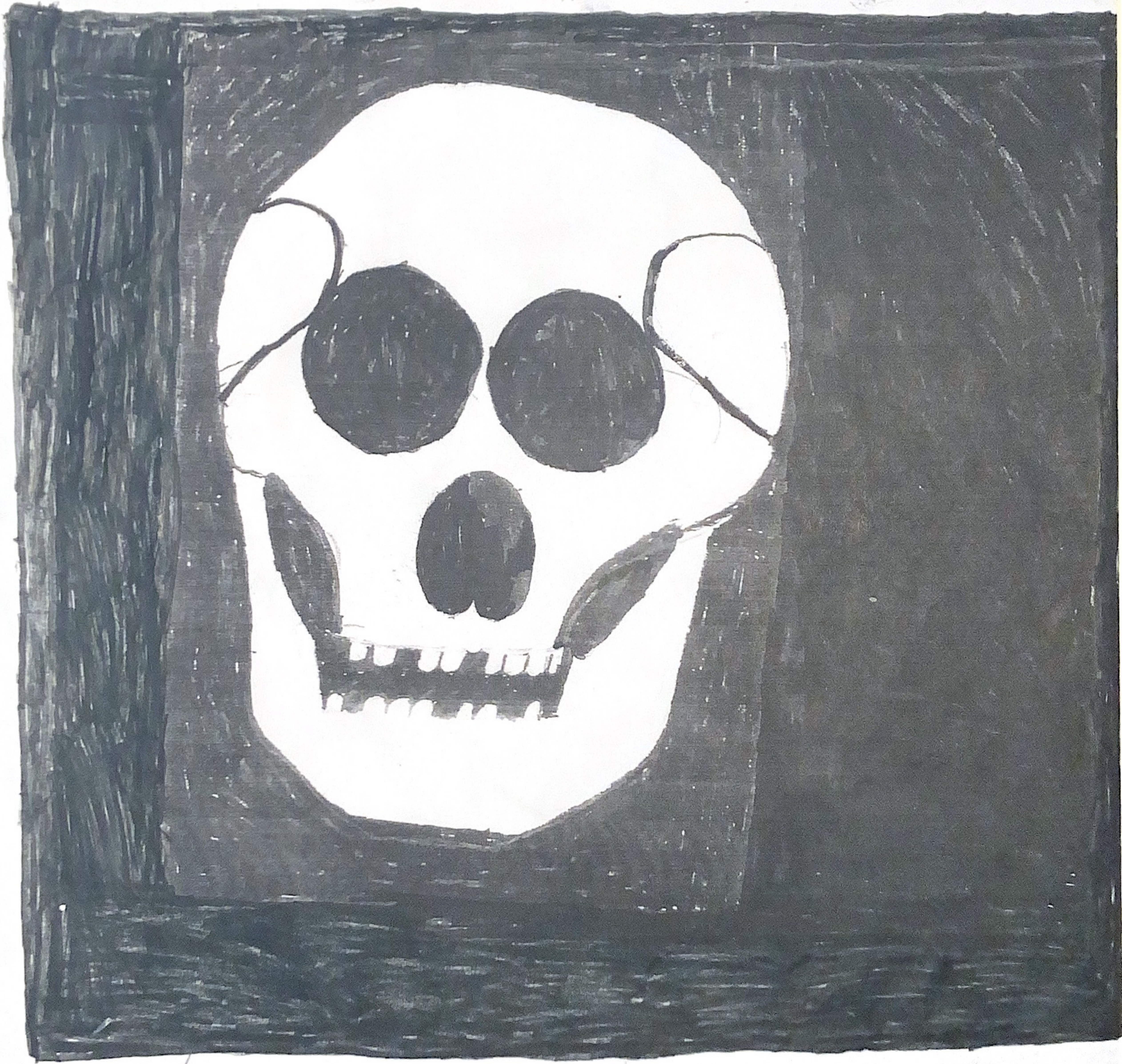
A couple of years after this, Henry Tudor of Lancaster came to England to fight Richard III.
