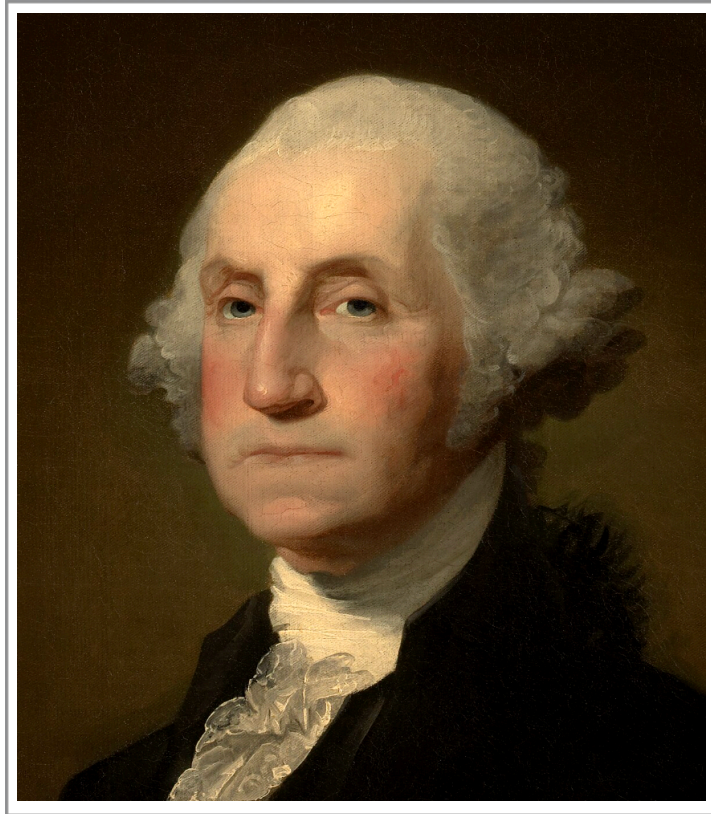


Foundations in History and Literature
