τύχη (τυγχάνω) the good which man obtains (τυγχάνει) by the favor of the gods, good fortune, luck, success

κλύδων (κλύζω) a wave, billow, and collectively surf Od.; a sea of troubles **συμφορά** συμφέρω an event, circumstance, chance, hap; the results, issues of the counsels.; a mishap, mischance, misfortune; in a good sense of the word, good luck, a happy issue
