 - EXAMPLE QUESTION: Who wrote "The Flax"? a) Nathaniel Hawthorne b) Hans Christian Andersen c) A. A. Milne d) Helen Hunt Jackson. *Answer*: b) Hans Christian Andersen
 - * the works and what they are about (themes and content).

 EXAMPLE QUESTION: Which of the following describes "The Ants' Monday Dinner"? a) It is a naturalist essay. b) It talks about the birth of a baby. c) It is about a boy who learns to be likable. d) It shows the struggle between a man's heart and brain. *Answer*: a) It is a naturalist's essay.
