- **Last Assignment.** This is your last assignment of the year, and this coming Friday is our last class!

- **Final Exam.** This coming week, we will be having a final exam. The exam will *not* include spelling or phonics. All of the questions are multiple choice or matching. The test should take you about twenty minutes to complete. I will be testing you on the following:
 - * vocabulary lists 1–31
EXAMPLE QUESTION: Which of the following is a synonym (same word) to *scarcity*? a) hearth b) fleece c) rogue d) famine. *Answer:* d) famine
 - * all of the literary words
EXAMPLE QUESTION: What is the literary word for “ridiculous humor”? a) theme b) epistolary c) farce d) protagonist. *Answer:* c) farce
 - * the *famous* authors and their works (know who wrote what): Hawthorne, Helen Hunt Jackson, Dickens, Kingsley, Longfellow, Hans Christian Andersen, etc. *Not* James Baldwin and Mr. Walter!
EXAMPLE QUESTION: Who wrote “The Flax”? a) Nathaniel Hawthorne b) Hans Christian Andersen c) A. A. Milne d) Helen Hunt Jackson. *Answer:* b) Hans Christian Andersen
 - * the works and what they are about (themes and content).
EXAMPLE QUESTION: Which of the following describes “The Ants’ Monday Dinner”? a) It is a naturalist essay. b) It talks about the birth of a baby. c) It is about a boy who learns to be likable. d) It shows the struggle between a man’s heart and brain. *Answer:* a) It is a naturalist’s essay.
