Classic Works of the Imagination Assignment 10

- Review the entire poem John Keats' "To Autumn" and be able to recite it in class.
- Finish reading a poems from one of my favorite works by Alfred Tennyson, *Idylls of the King*. The poem is titled "Gareth and Lynette." Answer the multiple choice questions in the study guide. Be ready to answer the questions for Class Discussion.
- The five-paragraph expository essay on George Orwell's *Animal Farm* explaining the fable as a satire of totalitarianism will be due **this coming** Friday. Remember the correct formatting of your paper:
 - * Include your name, date, and the title of your critical paper in the upper right hand corner of your paper (single spaced).



- * Remember the format of your paper:
 - Paragraph 1: Introduction. The last sentence will be your main idea. Paragraph 2: Body Paragraph 1, which begins with a topic sentence stating one aspect of totalitarianism satirized by Animal Farm. Example: One aspect of totalitarianism satirized by George Orwell in his allegorical fable is the tyrannical government's use of propaganda to sway public opinion. Then, explain your topic sentence and if appropriate, weave in a quotation from Animal Farm. Paragraph 3: Body Paragraph 2, which begins with a topic sentence stating one aspect of totalitarianism satirized by Animal Farm.
 - *Paragraph 4:* Body Paragraph 3, which begins with a topic sentence stating one aspect of totalitarianism satirized by *Animal Farm*.
 - Paragraph 5: Conclusion
- * Double space your essay. Do not put extra spaces between your paragraphs, and be sure to indent the first line of each.
- The picture on the upper right is of Gareth defeating the Knight of Noon Day.
