- *poetry bee blog.* Read and study this week's new poetry bee blog. Remember to review the old ones and to review all of the poems in the appendix. There will be additional poems to memorize for the final rounds of the bee.

- *poetry memorization.* Memorize Christina Rossetti's "Another Spring," stanzas 1–3. There are six stanzas in this poem.
- *literature.* Read the poems by William Wordsworth and complete the study guide material. Be sure to study all of the vocabulary. The picture on the assignment sheet is of William Wordsworth's homestead, Dove Cottage.
- *English history.* Read English History, chapter 21.

Long Range Assignment

- We will have the English literature *and* history exam on the **third Friday of March**.
