  9. ὄπλον -ου τό weapon, tool (mostly pl.)

  12. πολέμιοι -ων οἱ the enemy
  13. πόλεμος -ου ὁ war
  14. πόνος -ου ὁ work, stress, trouble, pain

  17. στρατός -οῦ ὁ army
  18. σύμμαχοι -ων οἱ allies
  19. τόπος -ου ὁ place, topic
