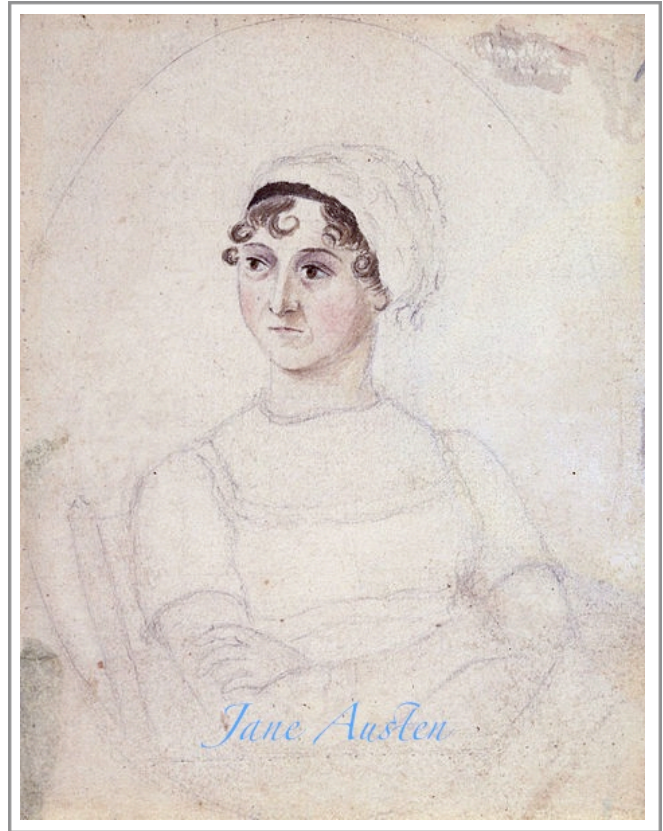


## Short Story Assignment 27

- While some of you have already sent it to me, at least half of you have not. You *must* have your final draft of the speech emailed to me *before* our next lesson.
- Read Chapters 8–16 in Jane Austen’s *Mansfield Park*. Answer the questions in the study guide, which is on the assignment page. The answers do not have to be written down, but please make sure that you formulate answers for class participation. If you do not yet have a copy of the book, it is also located on the assignment page.
- The essay on one or more of the satirical elements in Trollope’s *Warden* will be due next week—**third week of April**. Again, here is the format:
  1. Include a main idea as the last sentence of the first paragraph. Example: Through the character Tom Towers and his periodical *The Jupiter*, Trollope satirizes the arrogance, narrow-mindedness and inaccuracy of the media.
  2. Include a topic sentence for each of the body paragraphs, which will appear at the very beginning.
  3. Write a conclusion which talks about the significance of your discussion of Trollope’s satire. You *may* answer questions, such as *Is the satire still relevant today?* and *Does the satire reflect liberal or conservative views?*
