- *memorize quotation.* ἀετοῦ γῆρας, κορυδοῦ νεότης. "An eagle's old age (is worth) a sparrow's [crested lark's] youth"

Vocabulary of Quotation:

- * ἀετός eagle
 - * γῆρας old age
 - * κορυδός crested lark
 - * νεότης youth
- *picture.* On the right is a picture of a crested lark, which is common bird like our sparrow, found throughout Europe and parts of Asia. Notice the crest on its head which gives it its name.
 - *vocabulary.* Memorize the vocabulary for Lesson 44 in **Davis** on page 154, Section 372.
 - *grammar.* This week you are going to memorize the perfect active participle and the middle and passive participle; refer to the **participle sheet**. Also memorize Section 375 on the perfect indicative middle and passive. Read and take note of Section 376, which deals with verbs that end in a short vowel and Section 378, which deals with the pluperfect middle and passive, which has the imperfect personal ending. Read over Section 381.
 - *translation.* Translate Section 382 on page 158 in Davis, from Greek to English.
