
The Narrative Assignment 8

- Biography Assignment: Finish writing questions for the interview of your biography; you must have at least 15 questions.
- Write a paragraph summary of the event which will make up your ballad.
 The ballad will involve some adventure (like the Robin Hood ballads) or a recent tragic event—small or large.



Include most of the elements of the ballad that we discussed: superstition, foreshadowing, love, and an eerie mood.
