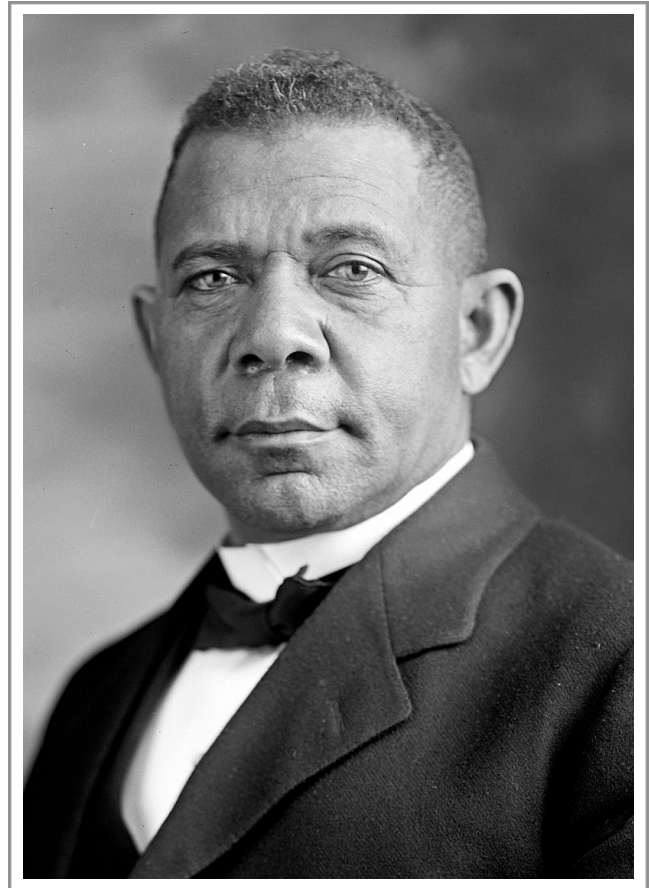


## The Narrative Assignment 8

- Read Slave Narratives: Frederick Douglass, “I Learn to Read”; Booker T. Washington (pictured right), “A Slave Among Slaves”; Harriet Jacobs, “A Visit to England”; Isaac Johnson, “Narrative of a Common Slave”
- Watch a **short youtube clip** short youtube clip about Booker T. Washington.
- Biography Assignment: Finish writing questions for the interview of your biography; you must have at least 15 questions.
- Write a paragraph summary of the event which will make up your ballad. The ballad will involve some adventure (like the Robin Hood ballads) or a recent tragic event—small or large. Include most of the elements of the ballad that we discussed: superstition, foreshadowing, love, and an eerie mood.
