- *memorize quotation.* ἀνδρῶν γὰρ ἐπιφανῶν πᾶσα γῆ τάφος, meaning “For illustrious men have the whole earth for their tomb.” The quotation is from Pericles' Funeral Oration found in Thucydides, *History of the Peloponnesian War* 2.43.3
